

Privacy Statement

Your personal data is processed by AMLA, who is the Controller, for the purpose of conducting outreach activities, including the distribution of newsletters, announcements, event invitations, and other communications about the work of AMLA. You can contact the Controller at: newsroom@amla.europa.eu.

You may contact the Data Protection Officer of AMLA at: dpo@amla.europa.eu regarding issues related to the processing of your personal data.

The categories of personal data processed include:

Name, professional email address, title/function, organisation, professional telephone number, and work address, where provided. Your data is collected directly from you when you subscribe or provide your contact details. In some cases, contact details of institutional stakeholders may be obtained from publicly available sources, such as the official website of their organisation. Providing your data is voluntary. However, without it, AMLA cannot include you in its communications.

The legal basis for processing your personal data is Article 5(1)(a) of Regulation (EU) 2018/1725 (public interest, based on Article 5 of the AMLA Regulation, establishing AMLA's tasks) for institutional stakeholders, and Article 5(1)(d) (consent) for individuals who voluntarily subscribe.

Your data will be kept as long as you remain a subscriber. The recipients of your data will, internally within AMLA, be the Communications Unit/Team and, where applicable, email service providers acting as data processors under appropriate contractual safeguards.

You have the right to access, rectify, delete, restrict, or object to the processing of your data, and to data portability, if the conditions in Articles 17 to 23 of Regulation (EU) 2018/1725 are applicable. Where consent is the legal basis, you may withdraw it at any time via the unsubscribe link or by contacting AMLA. If you would like to exercise any of these rights, please contact the Controller or the DPO. You have the right to lodge a complaint with the European Data Protection Supervisor (https://edps.europa.eu/data-protection/our-role-supervisor/complaints/edps-complaint-form_en) if you consider that your data protection rights have been infringed.

Your data will not be transferred to third countries or international organisations and is not used for automated decision-making, including profiling.
